THE ACADEMY OF THE HOLY NAMES is an independent, Catholic coeducational elementary school and a college preparatory high school for young women, founded in 1881 by the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary (SNJM). The Academy is the second oldest high school in the state of Florida, and is part of the larger SNJM network which includes schools in California, New York, Washington, Oregon and Canada.

With a tradition steeped in concern for social justice, the Academy has built a strong academic reputation. The school's distinctive mission makes it possible for the administrators and faculty to incorporate the rich intellectual discourse and humanitarian concerns of the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary into our programs.

The Academy of the Holy Names and its community values a unique educational model that is:

- Open to families of all faiths and backgrounds who share the school's mission and values;
- Respectfully responsive to the needs of diverse learners;
- Holistic in its approach to each individual's growth, development, health and wellness;
