If your child is suffering from seasonal allergies, please make sure to treat their allergies at home with any prescribed allergy medication before they arrive at school. If they are using eye drops, you may bring them to school to be administered in the clinic during the day to help with those awful itchy eyes that seem to be the biggest irritant at this time. You will need to fill out the appropriate medication authorization form if medication is to be administered at school. Parents/guardians may have to either bring medicine to school or pick up their child during the day if the student is not functioning well in the classroom.
