Revolution Prep is offering AHN sophomore and junior students a FREE online mock PSAT on Saturday, September 17th at 9 AM. This is an excellent opportunity to practice taking the PSAT and to get comfortable with the format and timing of the test prior to PSAT day in October. Seniors

A reminder that **ALL Florida public university college applications** must be submitted by **Friday, October 1** at the very latest. Please be diligent about also submitting your **self-reported grades** to the schools that have that requirement. Our priority deadline for all college applications is Tuesday, November 1.

December 1 is our FINAL deadline for submitting college applications. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Transcript request forms are available in the College Counseling office and in Maia Drive. Seniors are required to submit a transcript request form to their college counselor for every school they apply to. Please be mindful of all application deadlines. Transcript requests are processed on a first come, first served basis and must be submitted a minimum of 10 school days prior to any deadline.

Florida Bright Futures Program

The Florida Bright Futures Program provides scholarships for Florida residents who attend college IN-STATE, provided that they meet the academic criteria for eligibility.

On Wednesday, October 5th the <u>seniors</u> go online to register with the Florida Bright Futures Program before school at **8 AM**. Location TBA.

Seniors are required to register online with the Florida Department of Education in order to give the Academy of the Holy Names the right to release their academic information to the Department of Education.

Every senior is required to submit this form, whether or not she plans on attending college in Florida. (The Florida Bright Futures funds are made available to any student who initially qualified for the program at high school graduation, should she decide to transfer to a school in Florida during her undergraduate years in college.)

Florida Bright Futures Program, Cont'd.

It is critical for each student to provide her CORRECT Social Security Number to avoid major problems with obtaining her scholarship money. Also, each student will receive a letter from the Florida Department of Education in late December that will confirm submission of her Florida Financial Aid Form and this letter will contain a **pin number** that will allow the student to view her account online and to make any necessary changes in the future. **HANG ON TO THE PIN NUMBER!**

Your transcript will be submitted to the Florida Department of Education for review in early March. Approximately 75% of every graduating class at the Academy of the Holy Names qualifies for one of the two available Florida Bright Futures Scholarships: The Florida Academic Scholarship and the Florida Medallion Scholarship. College Fair 2022

Over 100 colleges and universities will be represented. This is an ideal opportunity to meet with college admissions counselors to gather information on schools that might be an ideal fit for you. Juniors are *strongly encouraged* to attend this event. Sophomores and seniors are welcome and eager freshmen may also attend.

Details on how to register for the fair and a list of participants will be distributed to students the week prior to the event.

Parking is free and available behind the Coliseum and across the street. Doors open promptly at noon and our shift ends promptly at 1:30 to allow the next shift of high schools to attend the fair, so please arrive on time to allow yourselves enough time to explore. This fair is for BAIS Schools ONLY. Please do not bring your friends from public schools or non-BAIS schools. They will not be allowed into the venue.

PSAT Testing

All freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will take the PSAT test on Wednesday, October 12, 2022

***Please note, the test begins promptly at <u>8:00 AM on a</u> <u>Wednesday!!!</u>

A planning guide for students and parents will be distributed to the students a week or two prior to the exam. Test results will be emailed to students from the College Board in early December.

The PSAT is a practice SAT to prepare students to take the SAT in the spring of the junior year. It is an excellent predictor of how a student will ultimately fare on the SAT. Please review the PSAT Student Bulletin and take the PSAT practice test prior to test day.

On test day, ALL students should come prepared with:

- Social Security numbers
- Sharpened #2 pencils
- Calculator

Students will report to their homeroom advisories on the morning of October 12 and begin testing immediately at 8:00 AM. Testing will end around 11:30 AM. Students must wear their school uniforms. Please contact the College Counseling Office if you have any questions.

2022 Financial Aid Workshop
